Subject: CCRTA Falmouth Town Report

The Cape Cod Regional Transit Authority (CCRTA) has provided a total of 97,061 one-way passenger trips across all services in the town of in Falmouth from July 2022 through June 2023 (FY23).

CCRTA provided 133 ADA trips for Falmouth residents. CCRTA also provided 18 Falmouth residents with 64 trips to Boston area hospitals through the Boston Hospital Transportation service.

CCRTA provided 319 Falmouth residents with 10,721 DART (Dial-a-Ride Transportation) trips during FY23. Total DART passenger trips in the fifteen towns of Cape Cod were 119,526 in FY23.

The fixed route Sealine serves the towns of Barnstable, Mashpee and Falmouth along Route 28. A total of 79,470 one-way trips originated in Falmouth for the Sealine for the period July 2022 through June 2023. Total ridership for the Sealine for this period was 155,457.

The seasonal service Woods Hole Trolley (WHOOSH) operates entirely within the Town of Falmouth. The WHOOSH had a total ridership of 6,673 for the period July 2022 through June 2023.

CCRTA supplied the Falmouth Council on Aging with two Mobility Assistance Program (MAP) vehicles that provided 3,553 rides from July 2022 to June 2023.
