Subject: CCRTA Mashpee Town Report

The Cape Cod Regional Transit Authority (CCRTA) has provided a total of 41,902 one-way passenger trips across all services in the town of Mashpee from July 2022 through June 2023 (FY23).

CCRTA provided 456 ADA trips for Mashpee residents. CCRTA also provided 11 Mashpee residents with 46 trips to Boston area hospitals through the Boston Hospital Transportation service.

CCRTA provided 148 Mashpee residents with 7,816 DART (Dial-a-Ride Transportation) trips during FY23. Total DART passenger trips in the fifteen towns of Cape Cod were 119,526 in FY23.

The fixed route Sealine serves the towns of Barnstable, Mashpee and Falmouth along Route 28. A total of 21,937 one-way trips originated in Mashpee for the Sealine for the period July 2022 through June 2023. Total ridership for the Sealine for this period was 155,457.

The fixed route Bourne Run serves the towns of Bourne and Mashpee. A total of 11,646 one-way trips originated in Mashpee for the Bourne Run for the period July 2022 through June 2023. Total ridership for the Bourne Run for this period was 21,378.

CCRTA supplied the Mashpee Council on Aging with one Mobility Assistance Program (MAP) vehicle that provided 1,260 rides from July 2022 to June 2023.
