Hyannis Transportation Center has had electric vehicle chargers for years <u>these are open to the public!</u>), and now CCRTA has installed **10 EV chargers at our Operations Depot** Using existing, previously unused electrical panels, we installed 10, 48 Amp Level 2 chargers along the outside wall of our bus service bays. Now our Operations Depot is ready to charge future EVs.

The Hatch ZEV Study has not only been delivering valuable information and planning insights, but it has also been building momentum for electric vehicles.

Action Steps for Collaboration


