**Subject: CCRTA FY25 Barnstable Town Report**

The Cape Cod Regional Transit Authority (CCRTA) has provided a total of 255,388 one-way passenger trips across all services in the town of Barnstable from July 2024 through June 2025(FY25).

CCRTA provided 1,430 ADA trips for Barnstable residents. CCRTA also provided 157 Barnstable residents with 559 trips to Boston area hospitals through the Boston Hospital Transportation service.

CCRTA provided 954 Barnstable residents with 48,005 DART (Dial-a-Ride Transportation) trips during FY25. Total DART passenger trips in the fifteen towns of Cape Cod were 115,283 in FY25. CCRTA’s ride-hail service, SmartDART , provided 29,583 trips for Barnstable residents.

CCRTA runs three fixed route services that operate entirely within the Town of Barnstable. The Barnstable Villager had a total of 29,303 trips, the Hyannis Crosstown had a total of 28,284 trips and the seasonal Hyannis Trolley had 9,920 trips for the period July 2024 through June 2025(FY25).

The fixed route Hyannis to Orleans (H20) serves the towns of Barnstable, Yarmouth, Dennis, Harwich, Chatham, Brewster and Orleans along the Route 28 corridors. A total of 36,094 one-way trips originated in Barnstable for the H20 route for the period July 2024 through June 2025. Total ridership for the H20 route for this period was 154,819.

The fixed route Sandwich Line serves the towns of Bourne, Barnstable and Sandwich via Route 6A, Route 130, Quaker Meeting House Rd, Race Lane, and West Main St. A total of 11,873 one-way trips originated in Barnstable for the Sandwich Line for the period July 2023 through June 2024. Total ridership for the Sandwich Line for this period was 31,088.

The fixed route Sealine serves the towns of Barnstable, Mashpee and Falmouth along Route 28. A total of 52,802 one-way trips originated in Barnstable for the Sealine for the period July 2024 through June 2025. Total ridership for the Sealine for this period was 163,953.



CCRTA also operates the CapeFLYER, a seasonal rail connection between Boston and Cape Cod, with its terminus in the Barnstable village of Hyannis. 4,990 riders boarded and 6,128 riders alighted the CapeFLYER train at the Hyannis terminus for the 2025 season. Total ridership for the CapeFLYER in 2025 was 14,944 compared to 13,588 in 2024.

CCRTA supplied the Barnstable Council on Aging with two Mobility Assistance Program (MAP) vehicles that provided 915 rides during the July 2024 through June 2025 time period.
