Subject: CCRTA Falmouth Town Report

The Cape Cod Regional Transit Authority (CCRTA) has provided a total of 110,126 one-way passenger trips across all services in the town of Falmouth from July 2024 through June 2025 (FY25).

CCRTA provided 150 ADA trips for Falmouth residents. CCRTA also provided 14 Falmouth residents with 60 trips to Boston area hospitals through the Boston Hospital Transportation service.

CCRTA provided 331 Falmouth residents with 8,308 DART (Dial-a-Ride Transportation) trips during FY25. Total DART passenger trips in the fifteen towns of Cape Cod were 115,283 in FY25. CCRTA’s ride-hail service, SmartDART provided 13,936 trips for Falmouth residents.

The fixed route Sealine serves the towns of Barnstable, Mashpee and Falmouth along Route 28. A total of 86,328 one-way trips originated in Falmouth for the Sealine for the period July 2024 through June 2025. Total ridership for the Sealine for this period was 163,953.

The seasonal service Woods Hole Trolley (WHOOSH) operates entirely within the Town of Falmouth. The WHOOSH had a total ridership of 7,535 for the period July 2024 through June 2025.

The fixed route Bourne Run serves the towns of Bourne, Falmouth and Mashpee. A total of 1,344 one-way trips originated in Falmouth for the Bourne Run for the period July 2024 through June 2025. Total ridership for the Bourne Run for this period was 22,066

CCRTA supplied the Falmouth Council on Aging with two Mobility Assistance Program (MAP) vehicles that provided 3,357 rides from July 2024 to June 2025.
